- 2. We encourage good sportsmanship through demonstrating and providing respect for all players, coaches, umpires, parents and the public at large at all games, practices and events.
- 3. We will place the emotional well-being of our children ahead of any personal desire to win.
- 4. We demand a drug, alcohol and smoke-free sports environment for our children and all children participating in the sport of baseball.
- 5. We must always remember that the game and the experience is primarily for the children and secondary for the adults.
- 6. We will encourage and teach our children to treat all players, coaches, parents, fans and officials with respect.
- 7. We will encourage and promote a team spirit and will endeavour to have our children attend all games, practices and events related to the baseball season.
- 8. We will discuss any differences with coaches, fans and officials away from all children in a calm and dignified manner. We understand that the coach is in charge and has the position of authority over the children during games, practices and events.
- 9. We will always remember to set an exemplary example in all respects of the sport of baseball for the children.
- 10. We will not accept or participate in bullying of any player, coach, official, or other parent physically, verbally, or emotionally.
- 11. Failure to comply with the above may result in temporary or permanent removal from the association.
